

# HOME ARTS AND CRAFTS DEPARTMENTS L, O, P, Q RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. Adults only in Department O.
2. No helper's passes will be issued in these Departments.
3. An exhibitor may enter only ONE ARTICLE IN A CLASS. No article may be entered in more than one class.
4. Even though there may be numerous articles entered in a class, if only one piece is worthy, premium is to be awarded at the discretion of the judge.
5. **FOR AMATEURS ONLY:** Those who teach as a profession or receive a percentage of income for their work will be considered professional and cannot exhibit, unless professional class is listed.
6. All reasonable care will be given in the protection of the exhibits but the Fair will not be responsible for any loss, which might occur.
7. Under Needlework, no article may be considered for premium which was manufactured commercially (all to be hand made or machine made as specified).

## FOODS DEPARTMENT L

Elimination will be made on the basis of appearance; final selection on quality and taste except canned goods. All preserved food should be exhibited in standard containers and must have been canned within the year. Standard containers refer to COMMERCIAL CLEAN GLASS JARS. The size of the jar to be used is specified at the start of each selection.

### STANDARDS FOR CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES

- **COLOR** – As nearly as possible to that of the natural fruit or vegetable.
- **CLEARNESS** – Syrup or liquid clear and free from seeds and bubbles.
- **PACK** – Arrangement with reference to symmetry and best use of space. As large a proportion of solids to liquid as possible. Uniformity of shape and size.
- **CONTAINERS** – ONLY metal screw band two-piece tops may be used. All foods not in standard jars or not sealed with self-sealing lids will be disqualified by the judge.
- **TEXTURE** – Uniformity ripened products firm enough to hold shape. No defective or overripe fruits or vegetables. Only young and tender vegetables should be canned. Jars will not be opened.

## JELLIES, JAMS, ETC.

### STANDARDS FOR JELLIES, JAMS, CONSERVES, BUTTERS, PRESERVES AND MARMALADES

- **JELLIES** – Made from fruit juice, should be clear (not cloudy) and firm enough to hold its shape when removed from jar; quivering; shape or angles retained when cut with a spoon.
- **PRESERVES** – Whole fruits or large pieces of fruits in clear thick syrup.
- **JAMS** – Made from crushed or macerated fruit, less firm than jelly, not stiff.
- **CONSERVES** – Jams made from a mixture of fruits including citrus. Sometimes nuts and raisins are added.
- **BUTTERS** – Made by cooking fruit pulp with sugar to a thick, spreadable consistency.
- **MARMALADES** – Made from pulpy fruits, with skin and pulp in a clear, jellied liquid. All should have natural fruit flavor; not too much or too little sugar.

**JARS SHOULD BE OF CLEAR GLASS, SEALED BY PROCESSING, NOT WITH PARAFFIN.**

### STANDARDS FOR YEAST BREADS

- **SIZE** – about 9" by 4" by 4"
- **SHAPE** – Oblong; uniform height in all parts.
- **CRUST** – Uniform golden brown, crisp and smooth.
- **CRUMB** – Well raised, equally light throughout; absence of heavy spots or streaks; not heavy for size; slightly moist; creamy white, not snowy white; tender but not crumbly; fine even grain; elastic when pressed lightly with the finger.
- **FLAVOR** – Sweet and nutty, no suggestions of sourness or taste of yeast.

## SECTION 12 – QUICK BREADS STANDARDS FOR QUICK BREADS

- **SIZE AND SHAPE** – Regular and uniform
- **CRUST** – Uniform golden brown, crisp in texture with a more or less glossy surface according to kind.
- **CRUMB** – Well raised, equally light throughout, absence of heavy spots or streaks and air tunnels; not heavy for size; slightly moist, tender, fine, even grain; elastic when pressed lightly with finger.
- **SWEET AND NUTTY** – No suggestions of sourness or taste of soda or baking powder.

## SECTION 13 – CAKES STANDARDS FOR CAKES

- **SIZE** – Medium. If layer cake, layers should be uniform in thickness.
- **SHAPE** – Level or very slightly rounded.
- **COLOR** – Cakes made with shortening – golden brown. Sponge cakes – light brown.
- **CRUST** – Cakes made with shortening – tender, smooth, thin. Sponge cakes – rough and slightly sugary.
- **FLAVOR** – No decided taste of shortening, egg or flavoring.
- **TEXTURE** – Cakes made with shortening – light, tender and easily broken with fine and uniform grain. Sponge cakes – light, tender and velvety; no signs of doughiness; fine-grained.
- **MOISTURE** – Slightly moist but elastic when pressed with the finger.
- **FROSTING** – Smooth and glossy in appearance, not granular. Spongy if cooked, not brittle; not so soft as to be sticky, mild in flavor, not highly cooked.
