

PUREBRED CATTLE DEPARTMENT B

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Competition is open to all with priority given to Chemung County residents.
2. All exhibitors of purebred stock must furnish the Judge or assigned person in charge with the proper certificate of registry at the time of judging.
3. Please state total number of animals to be shown on your entry. Give description of animal including its registered name and breed.
4. Exhibitor's herd shall consist of 3 cows, fresh at least once, 1 heifer, two years old, and 1 heifer, one year, under two and 1 heifer under one year old (total of 6 animals)
5. Breeder's young herd shall consist of 2 heifers, one year old and under two; 2 heifer calves, under one year bred and owned by the exhibitor.
6. All cattle exhibited in herds must be owned and registered in name of exhibitor. All cattle must be entered in name of bona fide owner.
7. Each exhibitor will be asked to cooperate in furnishing animals for the 4-H Judging Contest.
8. See Health requirements under General Rules and Regulations.
9. Exhibitors and families limited to 24 total animals.
10. All classes limited to no more than 3 entries per exhibitor unless otherwise specified.
11. Camper reservations – see entry blank for details.
12. One Helper pass will be given for each four animals entered by an exhibitor.
13. There will be NO TRAILER parking behind the Dairy/Livestock barns. Trailers will have to be parked in the infield.
